Description:

OIL WATER SEPARATOR consisting of: McTighe Industries model POWS-3000. Maximum design influent rate of 10,000 gal/day with oil recovery of approximately 290 gal/day. Each tank is vented to the atmosphere with no controls. The flash point of the collected oil is approximately 200 deg Fahrenheit, which should preclude significant emissions.

CONDITIONS:

1. The owner/operator (o/o) of this equipment shall comply with all of the Rules and Regulations of the District.
2. The o/o shall construct, operate and maintain this equipment in strict accord with the recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emission of contaminants practicable.
3. The o/o shall log on a quantity basis the oil fraction collected. This log shall be maintained current, on-site for a minimum of two (2) years and provided to District personnel on request.
