Description:

POL BIOREMEDIATION LANDFARM consisting of: Three (3) cells for containment of material to be remediated, located at the sanitary landfill on 8th Street. These cells are approximately 160' x 200' and 155' square. These cells are lined and sloped to preclude soil contamination. The soils will contain the following contaminants: Diesel fuel, MOGAS, anti-freeze solutions, hydraulic fluids, and oils. VOC emissions are logged through an existing spill reporting system. Included in this equipment are the necessary piping, valving, a 31,200 gallon water storage tank, a 61,000 gallon water storage tank, a leak detection system, and a PTO pump for delivery of water to the contaminated soil.

CONDITIONS:

- 1. The owner/operator (o/o) shall log all spills and their addition to the landfarm of all spills greater than 20 gallons. Additionally logged shall be the date of excavation from the site of spill, the type of material spilled and the date added to the landfarm.
- 2. The o/o shall log the number, approximate volume and the material of all other spills added to the landfarm on an annual basis.
- 3. The log shall be maintained current, on-site for a minimum of two (2) years and presented to District personnel on request.
- 4. This facility shall emit less than the following on a calendar year basis; Oxides of Nitrogen (NOx) 25 tons, Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) 25 tons, Particulate Matter less than 10 microns (PM10) 15 tons, and

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Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP) - 10 tons per year for any single HAP and 25 tons per year for any combination of HAPs.
