6. Visible emissions from this equipment shall not exceed an opacity equal to, or greater than, twenty percent (20%) for a period aggregating more than three (3) minutes in any one (1) hour, excluding uncombined water vapor.

7. The District shall be notified by the owner/operator in writing via email to reporting@mdaqmd.ca.gov a minimum of five (5) District working days prior to operation of this equipment at any location. At a minimum, the notification shall include the following:

- a. Date(s) of operation;
- b. Address of operation; and
- c. Contact information.

8. This unit shall not operate within 1000 feet of the outer boundary of any K-12 school. Proposed operations inside this boundary may require Public Noticing and or additional equipment restrictions. Therefore, any project proposed inside this boundary will require the submittal of a new application to revise this permit to operate. This is required to ensure compliance with the applicable requirements of the California Health and Safety Code Section 42301.6.
