1. Operation of this equipment in excess of 960 tons/day loadout, requires prior approval of the District.
2. Daily scale reading summaries shall be logged. These logs shall remain on-site for a minimum of two (2) years and be provided to District personnel on request.
3. Materials processed shall contain sufficient natural and/or added moisture to ensure compliance with District Rules 401,402, and 403.
4. Water shall be in truck's tank prior to loading of dry mix.
5. A flexible sock which extends 6" to 8" into the truck tank shall be used whenever dry mix is loaded into the truck.
