- 1. Operation of this equipment shall be conducted in accordance with all data and specifications submitted with the application under which this permit is issued unless otherwise noted below.

- 2.The owner/operator (o/o) shall maintain this equipment in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emissions of air contaminants.

- 3. This equipment shall operate concurrently with and vent to the air pollution control equipment operating under District permit C000632 (DCL 03).

- 4.This equipment shall not consume more than 46,800 MMBtu of fuel during any calendar year (360,000 gallons of diesel if fired exclusively on liquid fuel). [District Rule 1302(B)(1)(a)]
- 5.This equipment shall be fired on liquid fuel whose sulfur concentration is less than or equal to 0.0015% on a weight per weight basis. [District Rule 431]
- 6.The o/o shall maintain a fuel log for this equipment which, at a minimum includes the information specified below. This log shall be maintained current and on-site for a minimum of five (5) years and shall be provided to District personnel upon request.
- a. Fuel consumed during each calendar year, in gallons or BTUs; and,
- b. Fuel sulfur concentration (the o/o may use the supplier's certification of sulfur content if it is maintained as part of this log). [District Rule 1302(B)(1)(a)]
- 7.A facility-wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
