1. Operation of the equipment described above shall be conducted as described in the data and specifications submitted with the application under which this permit is issued unless specifically exempted hereunder.
2. This rock crushing, screening, and washing plant shall only be operated/maintained in strict accord with manufacturer's supplier's recommendations and/or sound engineering principles.
3. Roadways, work areas, stock piles, and materials being processed shall be kept wetted to control fugitive dust. Equipment to properly wet the material being processed shall be maintained in operable condition on-site and used as necessary to assure compliance.
4. Water sprays shall be used at conveyor points of charge and discharge, crushers, feeders, and screens to control fugitive emissions.
5. Daily production logs shall be maintained on-site for at least two (2) years and made available to District personnel upon request. This log shall contain, as a minimum, the tons of product produced per day, and the total number of hours operated.
6. The owner/operator shall comply with all applicable Rules and Regulations of the District. Applicable rules include, but are not necessarily limited to Rules 401, 402, and 403.
