3. Materials processed shall contain sufficient natural and/or added moisture to preclude violations of District rules 401, 402 and 403. Sufficient water and the equipment for adding it to the process and unpaved roads on the facility shall be maintained in operable condition at all times.

4. The total mass of materials processed by this equipment shall not exceed 700 tons in any day, and 16,100 tons in any calendar month.

5. A log for this equipment shall be maintained current and on-site for a minimum of two years, and shall be provided to District personnel upon request. The following information shall be recorded:

- a. Dates of operation;
- b. Brief description of types of materials processed; and
- c. Weight of material processed (in tons per day) and a description of the method used for the mass estimate.
