3. This facility is limited to producing no more than 400,000 tons per year of aggregate material. [District Rule 1302]

4. Roadways, work areas, stockpiles, and materials being processed shall be kept wetted to control fugitive dust. Equipment to properly wet the material being processed shall be maintained in operable condition on-site and used as necessary to assure compliance.

5. O/o shall maintain an operations and production log current and onsite for a minimum of two years and shall be provided to District personnel upon request. At a minimum the log shall contain:
 - a. The weight, in tons, of aggregate unloaded each day, summarized monthly and annually; and
 - b. Each operating location (in UTM or Lat/Lon).

6. This equipment may not operate at one facility for more than 12 consecutive months (this equipment shall be moved from one facility to another at least once every 365 days).

7. This equipment may be powered by line power or a generator driven by an engine with a valid District permit or State Registration (PERP).
