Description:

RESIN COMPOSITE MANUFACTURING consisting of: Resin composite manufacturing utilizing a sprayed mold release, resin wet lay-up and a vacuum bagging process. Facility utilizes electric curing ovens each less than 53 cubic feet, which are exempt per District Rule 219(E)(l)(13). Facility utilizes a rubber mill with additives that has been determined by the District to be exempt from requiring a permit.

CONDITIONS:

1. The owner/operator shall ensure that this equipment is installed, operated and maintained in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emissions of contaminants. Unless otherwise noted, this equipment shall also be operated in accordance with all data and specifications submitted with the application for this permit.

2. Facility shall use less than 20 gallons per month of Polyester Resin Materials.

3. Facility shall use less than 6.5 gallons per day, and less than 2,000 gallons per year of any resin and/or mold release agents combined.

4. A log pertaining to the operation of this equipment shall be kept on site for a period of two (2) years, and must be made available upon request of District personnel. This log shall contain, as a minimum, the following information:

- a) Date of operation;
- b) Manufacturer, type, and amount (in pounds or gallons) of resin, coating and solvent used (preparation, thinning, cleanup or other);
- c) VOC content of each type of resin, coating and solvent in pounds per gallon or grams per liter or percent (weight/weight);
- d) Organic solvent content of each type of resin, coating and solvent in pounds per gallon or grams per liter or percent (weight/weight);
- e) Daily records of VOC containing material and/or organic solvents used;
- f) Total amount of VOC and/or organic solvents used per calendar month; and
- g) Total amount of VOC and/or organic solvents used per calendar year.

5. This facility shall not emit greater than 1,190 pounds per month Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs).

6. If this facility uses any non-VOC organic solvents, including (but not limited to) acetone, dimethyl carbonate, propylene carbonate or methyl acetate, this facility shall not discharge into the atmosphere more than 600 pounds per day as calculated on a thirty (30) day rolling average.

7. A facility wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
