Description:

NEGATIVE AIR MACHINE consisting of: Critical Services, Model Mach II, SN 967. The 2 pre-filters have a combined arresstance of 99.5% for 2 micron particles; the HEPA filter is 99.9% efficient for all particles = or > 0.3 microns; operating @ 0-5" w.c. and 2000 cfm.

CONDITIONS:

1. The HEPA filters shall meet UL585 and UL900 Class 2 requirements.
2. This air filtration device shall be operated and maintained in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer.
3. This device may, at the discretion of the owner/operator, be used on any asbestos removal project in this District with proper 10 day notification consistent with Federal Register 40CFR Part 61. Proper notification is written and telephone communication a minimum of 10 working days before actual placement of this permitted equipment on the new site.
4. During full containment, view ports shall be provided for inspection purposes. The view port dimensions will be at least 18" x 18" and at a level not to exceed 3-4 feet from the ground to the bottom of the view port opening.
5. Viewing ports shall be sufficient in number to allow observation of all stripping and removal of ACM.
6. The allowable range for the pressure drop as indicated by the pressure guage is 1.2 to 2.5 inches W.C.
