CONDITIONS:

1. This equipment shall be installed, operated and maintained in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emissions of contaminants. Unless otherwise noted, this equipment shall also be operated in accordance with all data and specifications submitted with the application for this permit.

2. The o/o shall maintain a record of repairs and maintenance on this equipment and submit it to the District on request. The record shall be retained for a minimum of two (2) years, and this log shall be provided to District, State and Federal personnel upon request.

3. The o/o shall maintain on-site, as a minimum, an inventory of replacement cartridge filters that assures compliance with applicable Rules of District Regulation IV.

4. The o/o shall conduct a minimum program of inspection and maintenance (frequencies may be changed upon successful demonstration to the District that less frequent monitoring is equally effective). The o/o shall maintain current and on-site for two (2) years a log of the following information, which shall be provided to District, State and Federal personnel upon request.
