PORTABLE AIR POLLUTION CONTROL EQUIPMENT consisting of: Lincoln Electric Model Mobiflex 200-M KP1673-4, Serial Number TBD. One MERV 14 filter, part number KP1673-1, 19 inches in diameter by 24 inches tall. 325 sqft of filter area 735 dscfm

CONDITIONS:

1. Operation of this equipment shall be conducted in compliance with data and specifications submitted with the application under which this permit issued unless otherwise noted below.

2. This equipment shall be properly maintained and kept in good operating condition at all times.

3. The owner/operator is required to maintain an inventory of replacement filters for this control device. Plasma cutting is prohibited unless this control device is operated concurrently and maintained in proper working condition.

4. This equipment shall be operated concurrently with the hand held plasma cutting torch under valid District permit B014266.

5. Opening to extractor arm is required to be within 12 inches of plasma cutting such that visible emissions from plasma cutting operations are suctioned into the control device.

6. When the filter maintenance indicator light illuminates, plasma cutting operations shall immediately cease until such time as the filter maintenance has occurred and the properly operating control device is returned to operation and the indicator light is no longer illuminated.

7. An operation log shall be maintained on-site for at least two (2) years and be made available to District personnel on request. This log shall contain, as a minimum:

- a. Each date this equipment is operated;
- b. Date/time that the filter maintenance indicator light turns on
- c. Maintenance performed - includes filter maintenance and change outs

8. A facility wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
