Description:

INCINERATOR, CREMATORY (UNIT 2) consisting of: An American Crematory Equipment Co. Model A-200 HT Serial No. 20608-A natural gas-fired dual chamber crematorium. Primary chamber is equipped with one Eclipse Combustion Model TJ-50 Thermjet Medium Velocity burner rated at 500,000 Btu per hour, secondary chamber is equipped with one Eclipse Combustion Model TJ-100 Thermjet Medium Velocity burner rated at 1,000,000 Btu per hour, and the unit has a 5 hp blower motor. This device operates on 50% excess air with a nominal incineration temperature of 1500 degrees Fahrenheit (maximum operating temperature is 2000 degrees). Stack Height is 15 feet, Stack Diameter is 1.67 feet and operates at 1680 degrees F. Facility Elevation is 2965 feet above sea level.

CONDITIONS:

1. This equipment shall be installed, operated and maintained in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emissions of contaminants. Unless otherwise noted, this equipment shall also be operated in accordance with all data and specifications submitted with the application for this permit.

2. This equipment shall be operated by personnel properly trained in its operation.

3. A temperature of not less than 1500 degrees Fahrenheit shall be maintained in the afterburner (or secondary chamber) when the equipment it serves is in operation.

4.The o/o shall use regulated pipeline natural gas in this equipment. When natural gas service is interrupted, the o/o may use LPG.

5.The total quantity of material introduced into this equipment for incineration shall not exceed 600 pounds per batch, and this device shall not be operated for more than 3640 hours in any calendar year.
[District Rules 1302]

6.The o/o shall maintain an operational log for this equipment. This log shall be maintained current, on-site for a minimum of two years and provided to District, State or Federal personnel on request. The log shall contain the following at a minimum:

- a. Date, weight incinerated per batch, start time of each batch, and hours operated on that day;
- b. Cumulative monthly and annual hours operated;
- c. Volume of natural gas and/or LPG used on a calendar month basis;
- d. Date and time of all upsets and/or malfunctions; and,
- e. A description of all repairs or maintenance performed with date performed.

7.A facility wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
