Description:

SPRAY BOOTH - No. 2 consisting of: a Blowtherm of Dallas, Texas, their model "Ultra 2000". Each booth is approximately 14 ft by 25 ft by 11 ft high. Air is drawn through the system from outside air. This air is pre-filtered and then passes through a heat exchanger which ensures the proper temperature for the application for the paint onto the vehicle. Prior to this air going into the booth, it is filtered again with Speritex filters, 600 total, down to 10 micron particle size. This air enters the ceiling of the spray areas and exits through the floor thru over-spray filters. This air is exhausted to the atmosphere outside of the building.

CONDITIONS:

1. All coatings, diluents, thinners and solvents shall comply with District Rules 1116 and 442 in their entirety. These rules pertain to Automotive Refinishing Operations and Photochemically Reactive Solvents respectively.
2. A daily log shall be maintained of the VOC emissions from this facility which contains at least the following items:
 - A. Equipment used to apply coating.
 - B. Type of coating used and its VOC limit under each of the above applicable Rules.
 - C. Quantity of coating used and its VOC content.
 - D. Total VOCs generated by B. and C. above if covered by the above applicable Rules.
3. This log shall be kept current, on-site for a minimum of two years and provided to District personnel on request. (NOTE: The daily log information provides a basis for the Toxic Emission Inventory required by AB 2588.)

4. Discharge filters shall be installed and maintained in a tightly mounted and dimensionally stable condition free of excessive deposits or interference with air flow passages.
5. This equipment shall be operated and maintained in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer, or if manufactured by the applicant, approved by the District APCO.
6. Only High Volume Low Pressure spray equipment and/or those other methods described in District Rule 1116 (C)(2)(a) shall be used for applying coatings in this booth.
7. The o/o shall not use any motor vehicle or mobile equipment coating that contains hexavalent chromium or cadmium (Section 17 CCR 93112 - Airborne Toxic Control Measure for Emissions of Hexavalent Chromium and Cadmium from Motor Vehicle and Mobile Equipment Coatings). Compliance with this condition shall be verified by the retention of MSDS sheets (or equivalent documentation of chemical content) for every applicable coating used at the facility for two (2) years, and provision of said information to District, State or Federal personnel upon request.
