SPRAY BOOTH, AUTOMOTIVE consisting of:ASB, Spray Booth Manufacturing Company, Model SDF24U/SE2, 24' I x 14' w x 12' h; with two stacks 24' tall, 2' Dia, 18,224 cfm exhausted by two fan with a 1 Hp motor each and fiberglass type intake filters and fiberglass type exhaust filters. With no make-up air heated.

#### **CONDITIONS:**

1. The o/o shall not use any motor vehicle or mobile equipment coating that contains hexavalent chromium or cadmium (Section 17 CCR 93112 - Airborne Toxic Control Measure for Emissions of Hexavalent Chromium and Cadmium from Motor Vehicle and Mobile Equipment Coatings). Compliance with this condition shall be verified by the retention of MSDS sheets (or equivalent documentation of chemical content) for every applicable coating used at the facility for two (2) years, and provision of said information to District, State or Federal personnel upon request.

2.All coatings, diluents, thinners and solvents shall comply with District Rules 1116 and 442 in their entirety. These rules pertain to Automotive Refinishing Operations and Photochemically Reactive Solvents respectively.

- 3.A daily log shall be maintained of the VOC emissions from this facility which contains at least the following items:
- A. Equipment used to apply coating.
- B. Type of coating used and its VOC limit under each of the above applicable Rules.
- C. Quantity of coating used and its VOC content.
- D. Total VOCs generated by B. and C. above if covered by the above applicable Rules.

This log shall be kept current, on-site for a minimum of two years and provided to District personnel on request. (NOTE: The daily log information provides a basis for the Toxic Emission Inventory required by AB 2588.)

- 4.Discharge filters shall be installed and maintained in a tightly mounted and dimensionally stable condition free of excessive deposits or interference with airflow passages. The pressure drop across the discharge filters shall be within the range specified by the manufacturer and as measured by the manufacturer-supplied manometer, which is a Dwyer Model 25.
- 5. This equipment shall be operated in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer, or if manufactured by the applicant, approved by the District APCO.
- 6.Only High Volume Low Pressure spray equipment and/or those other methods described in District Rule 1116 (C)(2)(a) shall be used for applying coatings in this booth.

7.VOCs as determined in condition 2 above shall not exceed 10 tons/year.

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
