TANKS (HWAA) consisting of: 3 above ground steel tanks containing waste liquids (used oil, bilge, off-spec fuels). Total capacity for fee rate is 23,000 gal.

3000	Tank 9: Old Castle Convault rectangular tank, 7 feet x 6 inches W x 12 feet L x 5 feet H. for storage of off-spec F-24 aviation fuel.

CONDITIONS:

1. This equipment shall be installed, operated and maintained in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles in a manner consistent with good air pollution control practice for minimizing emissions. 2.The owner/operator shall strictly adhere to all Federal, State, and/or District rules and regulations which pertain to the storing, handling, transferring, transporting, and disposing of waste oils.

[District Rule 1302(C)(2)(a)]

3.No materials other than used oil, used hydraulic fluid and off-spec F-24 aviation fuel generated by this facility shall be stored in these tanks.

[District Rule 1302(C)(2)(a)]

4.All of the components of this tank, including but not limited to tanks, flanges, seals, pipes, pumps, valves, meters, connectors, shall be maintained and operated so as to prevent fugitive vapor leaks, fugitive liquid leaks, and excess organic liquid drainage during transfer, storage and handling operations. This condition shall be verified by a monthly inspection of the equipment. [District Rule 463(C)(3)]

5.The owner/operator shall maintain an operations log for this equipment, current and on-site (or at a central location) for a minimum of two (2) years, and this log shall be provided to District, State and/or Federal personnel, upon request. The log shall include, at a minimum, the information specified below:

- a. Record of liquids stored in this tank, verified by MSDS and by retention of the waste manifests issued upon disposal of waste oil.
- b. A log containing any repairs and maintenance conducted on this equipment.
- c. A log containing the date, time, and results of each inspection specified in Condition 4.

6. In each calendar year, the actual emissions of this facility shall be less than 20 tons NO_x, 20 tons VOC, and 12 tons PM₁₀ (SM80 Emission Rate). O/o shall demonstrate compliance with this limit on an annual basis through the submission of the Comprehensive Emission Inventory Report (CEIR) to the District. Copies of the CEIR(s) must be kept and maintained on-site for at least five years and presented to District personnel upon request.

7.A facility-wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
