Description:

STORAGE SILO, FLYASH consisting of: Plant Fabricators, Inc. (P.F.I.) capacity of 90,000 lbs of cement (6,700 gallons). Screw Coneyor 9' dia by 35'L, powered by a 25 hp electric motor.

CONDITIONS:

1. This equipment shall be installed, operated and maintained in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emissions of contaminants. Unless otherwise noted, this equipment shall also be operated in accordance with all data and specifications submitted with the application for this permit.

2. This equipment shall be used for the storage and transfer of flyash only.

3. During silo loading operations, emissions from this equipment must be controlled by the Air Pollution Control Device under valid District permit C015389 which must be operated during all loading operations.

4. This storage silo and associated equipment must be operated such that no visible emissions from the equipment result in an opacity greater than 20 percent on the Ringelmann Chart for a period or periods aggregating more than three (3) minutes in any one hour.

[District Rule 401(a)]

5. The owner/operator shall maintain current and on-site for two (2) years a log of the following information, which shall be provided to District personnel upon request:

- a. Monthly visible emissions evaluations (when silo is being filled) using EPA Method 22 (and EPA method 9 if Method 22 detects visible emissions. In lieu of Method 9, owner/operator may cease operations until deficiencies contributing to opacity are corrected.)
- b. Records of all maintenance and repairs.

6. A facility wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
