CONDITIONS:

1. Materials processed under this permit shall contain sufficient natural and/or added moisture to ensure compliance with District rules 401 and 403. Sufficient water and equipment in operable condition shall be maintained on-site and used as necessary to ensure compliance with the above mentioned rules.

2. Equipment described in this permit shall be operated in strict accord with the recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles and consistent with all specifications submitted with the application under which this permit was evaluated and issued.

3. The owner/operator (o/o) shall take opacity measurements on each of the three shaker screens on a daily basis and record the readings. The equipment shall not be operated unless all opacity readings measured on the three screens are less than 10%.

4. The (o/o) is limited to operation of this process at less than or equal to 200 ton/hour for no more than 16 hrs/day and not to exceed 2800 hrs/year (70% running time as proposed by the applicant). The o/o shall log the starting and stopping times of this process and the throughput on a daily basis. The log shall be maintained current, on-site for a minimum of two years and provided to District personnel on request.
