1. The owner/operator shall comply with all applicable Rules and Regulations of the District. Applicable Rules include but are not necessarily limited to Rules 401, 402, and 403.

2. Roadways, work areas, stockpiles, and materials being processed shall contain sufficient natural and/or added to ensure compliance with all applicable District Rules. Equipment to properly wet the material being processed shall be maintained in operable condition on-site.

3. Aggregate plant operation shall be restricted to a 12 hours per day and a maximum of 2376 tons per day of aggregate.

4. Daily production logs shall be maintained at either the facility or corporate office for at two (2) years and available to District, State, or Federal personnel upon request. This log shall contain, as a minimum, tons/day of aggregate processed.

5. The aggregate plant shall be operated/maintained in strict accord with manufacturer's and/or supplier's recommendations and/or sound engineering principles.

6. Entire plant emissions shall not exceed 3.04 tons per year of PM-10.
