2. This gasoline engine and its associated equipment cannot be operated at the same engine-print (spot) for more than 365 consecutive days, excluding time spent at a designated storage site. This equipment must be moved within this facility or moved to another facility annually for a valid operational reason.

[District Rule 1302 (C)(2)(a)]

3. This unit shall only be fired on gasoline.

4. A non-resettable four-digit (9,999) hour timer shall be installed and maintained on this unit to indicate elapsed engine operating time.

[District Rule 1302 (C)(2)(a)]

5. This unit shall not operate more than 16.92 hours per day (midnight to midnight).

[District Rule 1303(A)]

6. The owner/operator shall maintain an operations log for this unit, current and on-site (or at a central location), for a minimum of five (5) years, and this log shall be provided to District, State and Federal personnel upon request. The log shall include, at a minimum, the information specified below:

a. Date of each use;

b. Location of each use (decimal degrees, xx.xxxxx;-yyy.yyyyy);

c. Duration of each use (in hours as indicated by the hour timer);

d. Reason for use (regular prime use, emergency, testing & maintenance, etc.);

e. Calendar year operation in terms of fuel consumption (in gallons) and total hours; and,

f. Fuel sulfur concentration (may use the supplier's certification of sulfur content if it is maintained as part of this log).

7. This unit shall not operate within 1000 feet of the outer boundary of any K-12 school for more than 45 days. Such operation will require the submittal of an application for a revised permit to operate so that the applicable requirements of the California Health and Safety Code Section 42301.6 will be met.

8. A facility wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
