2.Water processed through this Tertiary treatment system shall begin the water treatment process beginning with the Headwork s system Permitted by valid District Permit B004784. Treated water shall only be used as recycled irrigation water; it is not potable water, and not meant for human consumption.

3. This facility shall not treat more than 2 millions gallons of waste water per day.

4. The owner/operator, o/o, shall log the daily volume of wastewater received and treated. The log shall be maintained current, on-site for a minimum of 2 years and provided to District personnel on request.

5. The o/o shall operate and maintain this equipment in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer and/or federal, State, regional and local waste water discharge permits

6. This facility shall emit less than the following on a calendar year basis;

Oxides of Nitrogen (NOx) - 25 tons,

Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) - 25 tons,

Particulate Matter less than 10 microns (PM10) - 15 tons, and

Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP) - 10 tons per year for any single HAP and 25 tons per year for any combination of HAPs.

Compliance shall be demonstrated annually to the District through the submission of a District approved Comprehensive Emission Inventory Report (CEIR) or other District approved equivalent method. The report shall be submitted to the District no later than April 30 of each year.
