Description:

PROCESS HEATER, NATURAL GAS consisting of: A custom built natural gas fueled 20 MMBtu/hour process heater that is designed to produce synthetic gas (syngas) from the pyrolysis of hospital / medical / infectious waste (HMIW) and includes the same equipment as that described in District Permit B012414. This permit excludes the introduction of any waste stream into the system and is issued for testing and break-in purposes only.

CONDITIONS:

1. This equipment shall be installed, operated and maintained in strict accordance with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emissions of air contaminants. Unless otherwise noted, this equipment shall also be operated in accordance with all data and specifications submitted with the application for this permit. [District Rule 1302]

2. The owner/operator shall maintain an operations log for this equipment on-site and current for a minimum of two (2) years, and this log shall be provided to District personnel on request. The operations log shall include the following information at a minimum:
 - a. Total operation time per day and per month, in hours; and,
 - b. Total fuel consumed on a monthly basis.

3. This equipment is limited to using only PUC-Regulated pipeline quality natural gas for fuel. [District Rules 431 and 1303(B)]

This permit is issued to allow testing, break-in, and commissioning operations on the equipment identified in District Permit B012414 without requiring the use of a fully functioning control device and extensive source testing requirements, and shall become null and void immediately upon having any waste introduced into the gasifier.

5. Visible emissions from this equipment shall not exceed 20 percent opacity (#1 on the Ringelmann Chart) for a period in excess of three minutes in any 60 minute period.

6. Operation of this system shall not cause a public nuisance as defined in District Rule 402.

7. Operation of this system shall not cause visible emissions to cross the property line of the facility.

8. A facility wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
