Description:

BLUE SMOKE RECOVERY SYSTEM consisting of: closed loop system which consists of condensing coils and vent/return lines. This system is necessary to preclude the emissions of "Blue Smoke Vapors" which may be generated during the filling or storing of asphalt storage tanks.

CONDITIONS:

1. Equipment shall be operated/maintained according to the recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles.

2. This equipment shall be operating concurrently with the Asphalt Batch Plant under valid District permit number B002468, and when the asphalt storage tanks are being filled or their contents are being heated under valid District permits T000314, T000315, T000316 and T002472.

3. Any Blue Smoke Vapors generated from the weigh hopper and pugmill (mixer) shall be collected/condensed/liquified and returned to the liquid storage asphalt storage tanks.

This air pollution control device must be operated such that no visible emissions from the equipment result in an opacity greater than 20 percent on the Ringelmann Chart for a period or periods aggregating more than three (3) minutes in any one hour. Compliance with this condition shall be demonstrated by monthly Visible Emission Determinations (VED) using USEPA Method 22, and USEPA Method 9, if necessary.

5. The owner/operator shall maintain a log of all inspections, repairs and maintenance on and to this equipment. The log shall be maintained current, on-site and provided to District personnel on request.

6. A facility wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
