Description:

BAGHOUSE consisting of: Serving Clinker and Gypsum Transfer System, valid District permit B000197: Dust Collector - DC17, N. Reclaimer Unimaster Dust Collector- DCEUMA 40-750, 1000 CFM, 250 square feet, 3 hp, Air-to-Cloth ratio of 4:1, Shaker Type

CONDITIONS:

1. The owner/operator (o/o) shall install, operate, and maintain this dust collector in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles.
2. The o/o shall institute a program of maintenance which embraces at least weekly stack observations, monthly visual inspections of all associated equipment (inclusive of the bags and their suspension system), and weekly measurements of the pressure differential across the bags.
3. The o/o shall log all the items in condition 2 above, including:
 - A. Date of weekly observation, whether or not visible emissions were observed from the stack, and maintenance procedure following if emissions were observed.
 - B. Date of monthly inspection and actions taken on equipment found to be operating below standards.
 - C. Date of pressure differential reading, whether or not it is within appropriate range, and maintenance procedure following if found to be outside of range.
4. The o/o shall maintain the log current and onsite for a minimum of five years and provide it to district personnel upon request.
5. The o/o shall maintain an inventory of the minimum number of replacement bags onsite at all times which ensures compliance with
