CONDITIONS:

1. Operation of this equipment shall be conducted in compliance with data and specifications submitted with the application under which this permit is issued unless otherwise noted below.
2. The owner/operator (o/o) shall have a continuing program of maintenance/inspections in accord with manufacturer's recommendations and specific`tions which ensures compliance with District Rules. This program shall include, but not be limited to, regular opacity readings, pressure differential measurements, and maintenance inspections. Logging of data shall be required with the log kept on-site for a minimum of two (2) years. This log shall be provided to District personnel on request.
3. The operating instructions shall be immediately available for use by the operator and provided to District personnel upon request.
4. This baghouse shall operate concurrently with equipment described as Screening & Conveying and "Regular" Pyro Bin on District permit B002486.
