Description:

BAGHOUSE DC22401 (RAYMOND MILL DRY PACK) consisting of: A DCE Model DU30RF11AD baghouse equipped with 20 19.5" by 24" by 59" L bags totaling 320 square feet of filter area and a 10 hp fan generating 2190 scfm (for an air to cloth ratio of 6.9:1). This unit serves the bag packers in the Raymond Mill building (B000849).

CONDITIONS:

1. This equipment shall be operated concurrently with the packaging equipment in the Raymond Mill building covered in District permit B000849.
2. The owner/operator (o/o) shall maintain this equipment in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emissions of air contaminants.
3. The o/o shall conduct a minimum program of inspection and maintenance on this equipment. The o/o shall maintain current and on-site for five (5) years a log of the following information, which shall be provided to District personnel upon request:
 - a. Monthly baghouse stack observation date and result (using USEPA Method 22, and USEPA Method 9 if necessary);
 - b. Quarterly bag and bag suspension system inspection date and results;
 - c. Quarterly reading of baghouse pressure drop, date and value;
 - d. Date of bag replacements; and,
 - e. Date and nature of any system repairs.

4. This baghouse shall discharge no more than 0.19 pounds per hour of PM10 at a maximum concentration of 0.01 grains/dscf at the operating conditions given in the above description. This equipment does not require a regularly scheduled emission compliance test.
5. The o/o shall maintain on-site a minimum inventory of replacement bags for this equipment that assures compliance with these conditions.
6. This unit shall be equipped with a device to measure the pressure differential across the bags (manometer).
