Description:

AIR POLLUTION CONTROL SYSTEM #17 (PROCESS LINE #1 COOLER) consisting of:Two Wolverine Model XSD120-24 double cyclone sets, each 71" D by 17' H cyclone equipped with a five hp rotary discharge valve. Each double cyclone set operates at 32,000 cfm; the combined system vents to a common 60" D by 110' H exhaust stack carrying 64,000 cfm.

CONDITIONS:

- 1. The owner/operator (o/o) shall maintain this equipment in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emissions of air contaminants.
- 2. This equipment shall operate concurrently with the fluidized bed cooler portion of Process Line #1 (B008780).
- 3. The o/o shall conduct a minimum program of inspection and maintenance on this equipment. The o/o shall maintain current and onsite for five (5) years a log of the following information, which shall be provided to District personnel upon request:
- a. Weekly common stack observation date and result (using USEPA Method 22, and USEPA Method 9 if necessary);
- b. Quarterly complete cyclone system inspection date and results; and,
- c. Date and nature of any system repairs.
- 4. This equipment shall not discharge into the atmosphere an exhaust stream that exhibits greater than twenty percent opacity.
- 5. This equipment shall discharge no more than 2.74 pounds per hour of PM10 at a maximum concentration of 0.005 grains/dscf at the operating conditions given in the above description (BACT).

An initial compliance test shall be performed during 2004; subsequent compliance tests shall be performed at least once every five years. The test results shall be submitted to the District not later than six (6) weeks prior to the expiration date of this permit during the applicable year.

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
