Description:

DUST COLLECTOR, CEMENT SILO consisting of: Lidell Model PJC-305, which is described as follows: 8 cartridge filters, 5 5/8" x 20" each with a total area of 315 sqft, driven by a 1,700 cfm fan with a pressure drop of 8" w.g.

CONDITIONS:

1. The owner/operator (o/o) shall maintain this baghouse in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emissions of air contaminants.

2. This baghouse shall be operated concurrently with the cement silo permitted under District permit T015388 is in operation.
[District Rules 1303 and 1320]

3. The o/o shall conduct a minimum program of inspection and maintenance on this equipment. The o/o shall maintain current and on-site for two (2) years a log of the following information, which shall be provided to District personnel upon request:
 - a. Monthly baghouse stack observation date and result, using EPA Method 22 (and EPA method 9 if Method 22 detects visible emissions. In lieu of Method 9, o/o may cease operations until deficiencies contributing to opacity are corrected.);
 - b. Annual bag and bag suspension system inspection date and results;
 - c. Date of bag replacements; and,
 - d. Date and nature of any system repairs.

4. The o/o shall maintain on-site a minimum inventory of replacement bags that assures compliance with these conditions.

[District Rule 1303(A)]

5. Emissions from the entire facility shall not exceed the following limits:

- a. Particulate Matter 10 microns and less (PM10): 12 tons per consecutive twelve month period;
- b. Any single Hazardous Air Pollutant (HAP): 8 tons per consecutive twelve month period; and
- c. All HAPs combined: 20 tons per consecutive twelve month period.

Compliance shall be demonstrated to the District through the submission of a District approved Comprehensive Emission Inventory Report (CEI) or other equivalent and District approved method.

[District Rules 1302 and 1320]

6. A facility wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
