SPRAY BOOTH - PAINT consisting of:Manufactured by Binks, model CASC533, 14'0"W x 9'0"H x 26'0"D w/5.0 hp exhause fan when painting and 0.25 hp when drying plus 20 intake and 20 exhaust filters 20" x 20" x 1" thick, manometer and 24 electric heaters totaling 78,000 watts. Located in the Auto Paint Classroom.

CONDITIONS:

- 1.All coatings, solvents, application equipment and cleaning methods shall comply with District Rule 1116.
- 2.A daily record shall be maintained of the VOC emissions from this facility which contains at least the following items:
- A. Equipment used to apply coating.
- B. Type of coating used and its VOC limit under each of the above applicable Rules.
- C. Quantity of coating used and its VOC content.
- D. Total VOCs generated by B and C above if covered by the above applicable Rules.

This log shall be kept current, on-site for a minimum of two years and provided to District personnel on request. (NOTE: The daily log information provides a basis for the Toxic Emission Inventory required by AB 2588.)

3.Discharge filters shall be installed and maintained in a tightly mounted and dimensionally stable condition free of excessive deposits or interference with air flow passages.

- 4. This equipment shall be installed, operated and maintained in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer, or if manufactured by the applicant, approved by the District APCO.
- 5.Only High Volume Low Pressure spray equipment and/or other methods approved in writing by the District APCO shall be used at this facility.
- 6.This facility (all spray booths) is limited to less than 25 pounds per day of operation of VOC emissions based on the logging of materials used in conditions 2, above, as well as all future sources.

7.The o/o shall not use any motor vehicle or mobile equipment coating that contains hexavalent chromium or cadmium (Section 17 CCR 93112 - Airborne Toxic Control Measure for Emissions of Hexavalent Chromium and Cadmium from Motor Vehicle and Mobile Equipment Coatings). Compliance with this condition shall be verified by the retention of MSDS sheets (or equivalent documentation of chemical content) for every applicable coating used at the facility for two (2) years, and provision of said information to District, State or Federal personnel upon request.

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
