Description:

CALORIA DAY TANK consisting of: T-100, 20,000 gallon, steel, above ground.

CONDITIONS:

1. This tank stores HTF Light Ends (the condensible fraction of the vapors vented from the ullage system) for disposal. This tank must be properly maintained.

2. If current non-criteria substances become regulated as toxic or hazardous substances and are used in this equipment, the owner/operator (o/o) shall submit to the District a plan demonstrating how compliance will be achieved and maintained with such regulations.

3. The combined emissions from SEGS I and SEGS II shall be less than the following limits:
 - a. 8 tons per year of any single HAP or 20 tons per year of any combination of HAPs on a 12 month calendar year basis
 - b. 15 tons of PM10 on a 12 month calendar year basis
 - c. 20 tons of NOx on a 12 month calendar year basis
 - d. 20 tons of VOC on a 12 month calendar year basis
 Compliance with this limit shall be verified with monthly facility emission summaries and an annual emissions inventory. Monthly emissions summaries shall be calculated using a District-approved method, with at least the last two years of monthly emissions summaries maintained and available to be provided to District, State or Federal personnel upon request. The facility must also submit an accurate emissions inventory data to the District, in a format approved by the District, on a yearly basis, which is to be received by the District no later than April 30 of each year.
