PARTS WASHER (SALT WELLS BLDG 15950) consisting of: A tank manufactured by R & D, measuring 45 inches x 24 inches x 17 inches, used for soaking research and development materials.

CONDITIONS:

1. This tank shall be provided with a tight fitting cover, which shall be closed when the tank is not in use.

2. The solvent used in this tank is limited to acetone (CAS 67-64-1). This solvent shall not be heated above ambient temperature.

3. This tank shall have at least 6 inches of freeboard after immersion of items to be cleaned.

4. Parts shall be added and removed in such a manner to preclude splashing and parts being removed shall be visually dry before removal.

5. The vertical speed of the hoist shall not exceed eleven (11) feet per minute when such a hoist is used.

The owner/operator shall maintain an operations log for this unit current and on-site (or at a central location) for a minimum of five (5) years, and this log shall be provided to District, State and Federal personnel upon request. The log shall include, at a minimum, the information specified below:

- a. Type of solvent used;
 - b. Dates and amounts of solvent added;
 - c. Records of all maintenance and repairs to the system; and
 - d. Total solvent usage for each rolling consecutive twelve month period;
