3. This tank is for the storage of the materials specified in the equipment description. Owner operator shall contact the district prior to any change to the material stored in each of the listed tanks.

4. A log shall be maintained which contains at least the following:

- a. Date of inspection;
- b. All repairs/additions made to equipment.
- c. Date and quantity and VOC content of material added to each tank.
- d. Monthly emissions inventory data for all applicable substances used for clean up and or the production of flooring adhesives on a facility wide basis
- e. MSDS for all substances used for clean up and or the production of flooring adhesives on a facility wide basis

This log shall be maintained current, on-site for a minimum of two years and provided to District personnel on request.

5. Total VOC emissions from this equipment shall be less than 25 lbs/day as verified by current emissions inventory report.

6. This facility shall emit less than the following on a calendar year basis:

- a. Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) - 20 tons
- b. Particulate Matter less than 10 microns (PM10) - 12 tons, and
- c. Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAP) - 8 tons per year for any single HAP and 20 tons per year for any combination of HAPs.

Compliance shall be demonstrated annually to the District through the submission of a District approved Comprehensive Emission Inventory Report (CEIR) or other District approved equivalent method. The report shall be submitted to the District no later than April 30 of each year.
