3. The owner/operator (o/o) shall use only diesel fuel whose sulfur concentration is equal or less than 0.05% on a weight basis. The o/o may use the supplier's furnished certification of sulfur content if the certifications are maintained on file.

4. This equipment does not require a regularly scheduled emission compliance test. However, emission compliance testing may be required at the discretion of the District.

5. The o/o shall maintain a log for this unit, which, at a minimum, contains the information specified below. This log shall be maintained current and on-site for a minimum of two (2) years and shall be provided to District personnel on request:

- a. Date of each use;
- b. Duration of each use, in minutes;
- c. Fuel consumed during each calendar year, in gallons;
- d. Fuel sulfur concentration
