1. The owner/operator, o/o, shall install, operate and maintain this equipment in strict accord with the recommendations of the manufacturer.
2. The submittal to the application, under which this permit is issued, is incorporated into this permit in its entirety and it acts as strict limitations on the operation of the equipment described hereon, unless specifically exempted hereunder.
3. The o/o shall install, operate and maintain water spray systems on the crusher, screens and conveyor belt transfer points. The sprays shall operate concurrently whenever the equipment is used to process the rock/minerals.
4. Materials processed by equipment delineated above shall contain sufficient and/or added moisture to ensure compliance with District rules 401, 402 and 403. Sufficient water and equipment in operable condition shall be maintained on-site and used as necessary to ensure compliance with these rules. Included in this condition are the haul roads used in the plant and any storage piles.
5. The o/o shall log the amount of material to the primary crusher on a daily basis. The log shall be kept current, on-site for the duration of the project and provided to District personnel on request.
6. The o/o is limited to 400,000 tons of material to the primary crusher for the duration of this project at this site.
7. The o/o shall notify the District as soon as the California State Certified Electricity Generator is placed on-site and fax a copy of the certification sheet to the District (760.245.2022) at that time. Please cross-reference the fax to FILE: B008138.
