CONDITIONS:

1. This equipment shall only be operated/maintained in strict accord with manufacturer's/supplier's recommendations and/or sound engineering principles.

2. Plant operations shall be restricted to a maximum combined material throughput of 416 tons per day (tpd).

3. The owner/operator shall comply with all applicable Rules and Regulations of the District. Applicable rules include, but are not necessarily limited to Rules 401, 402, 403, 404, 405, and 430.

4. Roadways, work areas, stockpiles, and materials being processed shall contain sufficient natural and/or added moisture to ensure compliance. Equipment to properly wet the material being processed shall be maintained in operable condition on-site and used as necessary to assure compliance.

5. Block curing may be facilitated by use of facility kilns 1 through 14 powered by process heat from boiler permitted under District permit number B008611.

6. Daily production logs shall be maintained on-site for at least two (2) years and made available to District personnel upon request. This log shall contain, as a minimum, the combined material throughput (mix) in tpd, and daily hours operated.
