3. Roadways, work areas, stock piles, and materials being processed shall be kept wetted to control fugitive dust. Equipment to properly wet the material being processed shall be maintained in operable condition on-site and used as necessary to assure compliance.
4. Water sprays shall be used at conveyor points of charge and discharge, crusher, and feeders, to control fugitive emissions.
5. Daily production logs shall be maintained on-site for at least two (2) years and made available to District personnel upon request. This log shall contain, as a minimum, the tons of product produced per day, and the total number of hours operated.
6. The owner/operator shall comply with all applicable Rules and Regulations of the District. Applicable rules include, but are not necessarily limited to Rules 401, 402, and 403.
7. Mechanical power shall be provided by a Caterpillar Diesel Engine, Model 3306 DITA, permitted under District permit B008576.
8. Operation of this equipment is limited to 7.5 hours/day maximum.
