2. The owner/operator, o/o, shall install, operate and maintain this equipment in strict accord with the recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier.

3. The o/o shall notify the District within 10 days of moving this equipment to a new location in the District.

4. The o/o shall log the throughput to the system as it is used, in ton/h. This log shall be kept current, on-site and provided to District personnel on request.

5. Sufficient natural and/or added water shall be maintained in the materials added to the hopper in the description above to preclude violations of District Rules 401, 402 and 403. Adequate supplies of water and the necessary equipment to add it to the material entering the hopper shall be maintained on-site and used as necessary. This condition also applies to haul roads and other roads at the facility where this equipment is used.
