3. A timer shall be installed and maintained on this unit to indicate elapsed engine operating time.

4. The o/o shall maintain a log for this unit, which, at a minimum, contains the information specified below. This log shall be maintained current and on-site for a minimum of two (2) years and shall be provided to District personnel on request:
 - a. Date of each use;
 - b. Duration of each use, in hours;
 - c. Annual operation in terms of total calendar year fuel use (in gallons) or hours;
 - d. Fuel sulfur concentration (the o/o may use the supplier's certification of sulfur content if it is maintained as part of this log).

5. Operation of this equipment shall be conducted in accordance with all data and specifications submitted with the application under which this permit is issued unless otherwise noted below.

6. Roadways, work areas, stock piles, and materials being processed shall be kept wetted to control fugitive dust. Equipment to properly wet the material being processed shall be maintained in operable condition on-site and used as necessary to assure compliance.

7. The owner/operator shall comply with all applicable Rules and Regulations of the District. Applicable rules include, but are not necessarily limited to Rules 401, 402, 403, and Rule 1303.

8. The operation of this equipment shall be limited to four (4) hours per day based on engine emission information submitted with the application and Rule 1303. The actual emissions from this engine may be determined by conducting an emission source test at the option of the o/o.
