3. The o/o shall maintain a log of all inspections, repairs and maintenance on this equipment and submit it to the District upon request. The log shall be kept for a minimum period of two (2) years.

4. The o/o shall not be required to conduct compliance tests relative to District Rules 404 and 405 while this unit is nonoperational.. Testing shall resume upon startup and shall be conducted every three (3) years of operation thereafter. The test results shall be submitted to the District not later than six (6) weeks prior to the expiration date of this permit in those years applicable.
