**Description:**

DUST COLLECTORS (DRY SIZING) consisting of: two dust collectors serving the dry sizing area: a Donaldson Model Torit FHG12-0012 dust collector, equipped with cartridge filters totaling 180 square feet of filter area and a one hp fan generating 300 acfm of flow through the filters (for an air to filter ratio of 1.67 to 1); and a British Rema Manufacturing Co. Model Minisplit Classifier dry sizer. This equipment is permitted as a system as this equipment cannot operate independently of the dry sizing process.

**CONDITIONS:**

1. The owner/operator (o/o) shall maintain this equipment in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer/supplier and/or sound engineering principles which produce the minimum emissions of air contaminants.

2. This equipment shall operate concurrently with the dry elutriation process.

3. The o/o shall conduct, at a minimum, the following inspections and maintenance on this equipment. The o/o shall maintain current and on-site for two (2) years a log of this information, which shall be provided to District personnel upon request:
  - a. Quarterly dust collector stack observation date and results;
  - b. Quarterly filter and filter suspension system inspection date and results;
  - c. Date of cartridge replacements; and,

This equipment shall not discharge particulate matter 10 microns or less in aerodynamic diameter (PM10) at a concentration in excess of 0.006 grains/dscf at the operating conditions given in the above description (BACT). This equipment does not require a regularly scheduled emission compliance test and such testing must only be conducted upon District request.
