**Description:**

ACTIVATED CARBON INJECTION SYSTEM consisting of: A system comprised of a locally controlled hoist/trolley that places a bulk bag of activated carbon sorbent (used to control mercury emissions) over a hopper and gravimetric controlled screw feeder assembly that discharges into a solids educator and conveying line with motive air from a positive displacement blower. This system is equipped with a 15 bhp blower and a 3 pneumatic conveying line, rated at 225 scfm.

**CONDITIONS:**

1. This equipment shall be installed, operated and maintained in strict accordance with those recommendations of the manufacturer which produce the minimum emissions of contaminants. Unless otherwise noted, this equipment shall also be operated in accordance with all data and specifications submitted with the application for this permit.
2. The owner/operator shall comply with all applicable Rules and Regulations of the District. Applicable rules include, but are not limited to Rules 401, 402, 403 and 430.
3. The transfer point associated with this system must be well-sealed as designed.

4. This system must not process more than 365 tons of carbon sorbent in any twelve (12) month period.

6. The owner/operator shall maintain a log, current and on-site, for five (5) years, and provide it to District personnel upon request. This log shall contain, at a minimum:

- (a) Monthly tonnage of carbon sorbent processed; and,
- (b) Date and description of repairs and maintenance performed on this system.

7. A facility wide Comprehensive Emission Inventory (CEI) for all emitted criteria and toxic air pollutants must be submitted to the District, in a format approved by the District, upon District request.
