SPRAY BOOTH - PAINT consisting of: Paint Arrester Floor Type, model 30-4206, 6'W x 7'H x 4'D, with 12 20" x 20" exhaust filters and 1.5 hp exhaust fan.

CONDITIONS:

1. This equipment shall be installed, operated and maintained in strict accord with those recommendations of the manufacturer which produce the minimum emissions of contaminants. Unless otherwise noted, this equipment shall also be operated in accordance with all data and specifications submitted with the application for this permit.
2. Discharge filters shall be installed and maintained in a tightly mounted and dimensionally stable condition free of excessive deposits or interference of air flow passages.
3. This equipment shall be operated in compliance with all applicable rules and regulations, including but not limited to District Rule 442 - Usage of Solvents, District Rule 1114 - Wood Products Coating Operations, and District Rule 1115 - Metal Parts & Products Coating Operations.
4. The total amount of VOC emitted from this equipment shall VOC Containing materials which are not subject to the VOC limits of any other rule found in District Regulation IV - Prohibitions, or in any rule found in the District Regulation XI - Source Specific Standards, shall not exceed 1,190 pounds per month, calculated on a thirty (30) day rolling total (the preceding 30 day period, plus the current day's VOC emissions).

5.A daily log shall be maintained for the VOC-containing products used and/or emitted from this equipment. The log shall contain at least the following:

- a. Type of material to be coated (wood, metal, plastic, etc.) and the applicable rule for the coatings to be used (442, 1114, 1115, etc.).
- b. Type of coating material (thinner, primer, basecoat, topcoat, solvent, etc.) and its applicable VOC limit, if any, in pounds per gallon.
- c. Manufacturer of the coating material, and the manufacturer's product name and/or code number;
- d. Quantity of each coating material used, and its VOC content in pounds per gallon;
- e. Total VOC emissions per day and the current thirty (30) day rolling total calculated pursuant to condition 4; and,
- f. Copies of the Environmental Data Sheet and/or Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) for each coating, diluent, thinner, and solvent used.

The VOC log shall be kept current, on-site for a minimum of five (5) years, and provided to District personnel on request.

These records shall be kept for a minimum of five (5) years and made available to District, state, and/or federal personnel upon request.

6.Pursuant to 40 CFR 63 subpart HHHHHH, this facility shall not spray apply coatings to metal and plastic surfaces that contain compounds of chromium (Cr), lead (Pb), manganese (Mn), nickel (Ni), or cadmium (Cd). Contact the MDAQMD for conditions if this facility will use coatings containing these compounds and/or MeCl for additional permits requirements.
